Subject: – Criteria for Grace marks.

In connection to memo no. 13534/HSBTE dated 18.10.2012, it is intimated that the following decisions are taken regarding the criteria for grace marks in present examination system.

If a candidate who has appeared in theoretical & practical subjects in a semester exam & has passed in all theoretical, practical & sessional subjects & in aggregate except one theoretical subject by a maximum of 5 marks, he/she will be declared to have passed the examination after adding the grace marks.

If a candidate who has appeared in theoretical & practical subjects & has passed in all subjects except two theoretical subjects by not more than 5 marks in both subjects taken together, he/she will be declared to have passed the examination after adding grace marks.

All the principals are requested to award grace marks in one/two subjects by not more than maximum 5 marks in both subjects taken together for clearing the Diploma of the concerned students. (Other than this, there will be no grace marks)
